- **Upper Nave and Choir Loft Windows – Depictions of the Rosary**
  - Joyful Mysteries
    - The Annunciation – over the South Entrance
    - The Visitation
    - The Nativity
    - The Presentation
    - The Finding of Jesus in the Temple
  - Sorrowful Mysteries
    - The Agony in the Garden – south side nearest the Choir Loft
    - The Scourging at the Pillar
    - The Crowning with Thorns
    - The Carrying of the Cross – north side nearest the Choir Loft
    - The Crucifixion – center Choir Loft window
  - Glorious Mysteries
    - The Resurrection
    - The Ascension
    - The Descent of the Holy Spirit
    - The Assumption
    - The Coronation – over the North Entrance
  
- **Nave Side Niches**
  - South
    - Cure of Ars – John Vianney
    - Boniface
    - Benedict
    - Dominic Savio
  - North
    - Rose of Lima
    - Bridget
    - Guardian Angel
    - Mother Cabrini
  
- **Baptistry / Chapel**
  - North – St. Hilary of Poitiers
  - East – St. John the Baptist
  - West – Baptism of Jesus

- **Vestibules & Sanctuary Passage**
  - California – these are copies of the originals which were stolen decades ago
    - Keys to the Kingdom – center
    - St. Peter and the Church – south
    - St. Peter and the Holy Spirit – north
  - North Vestibule (2), South Vestibule (2), Sacristy restroom (1), and Sanctuary Passage (5) have emblem windows with these symbols:
    - Alpha & Omega
    - Cross with Palm
    - Sacred Heart with Thorns
    - Oil Lamp
    - Menorah
    - Eye of God, All Seeing Eye, Eye of Providence
    - Rose
    - Cross with Crown, Scale of Justice, and Thorns
    - Lilies
    - Chalice & Host
    - Wheat
    - Grapes
    - Sacred Heart with Flowers
    - IHS – monogram of the name of Jesus taken from the Greek spelling
    - MA with Cross – Mu (today) Alpha (first, beginning)
  
- **Priest Sacristy**
  - Eye of God, All Seeing Eye, Eye of Providence
  - Holy Spirit
  - Crown with Palm
  
- **South Antechamber (former Reconciliation Room)**
  - The Good Shepherd
  - Little Flower – Therese of Lisieux
  
- **North Antechamber (Ushers Room)**
  - Peter
  - Paul
  
- **Server Sacristy (north antechamber behind the Sacristy)**
  - Alpha & Omega
  - Chio Rho – monogram of the first two letters of Christ from the Greek spelling
  - Loaves and Fish
  
- **Candle Room (south antechamber behind the Risen Christ altar)**
  - Wheat and Grapes
  - Pelican and Chicks
