














12. Which would best describe your assessment of the physical shape of your Church building?






- Lots of Character! Really nice structure and "bones" but







14. What is your most preferred method of bringing others closer to Christ?



15. To what degree do you think your parish needs to change in order to best fulfill its mission in the next 5 years.












16. Please select the phrase that best describes the relationship between your parish elementary/middle school and the parish from your perspective?

- Of one space! Most of the families in the school don't belong to the parish and they really are two different communities.




What Drives a Parishioner to Recommend their Parish to a Friend and to Indicate the Parish is Helping them Grow Spiritually?








What Drives a Parishioner to Share a Personal Witness Story?








